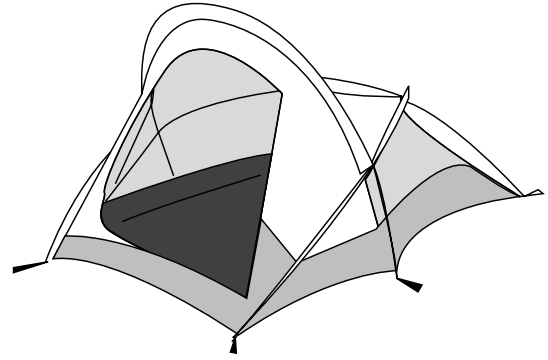


TourLite Duo Tent

Thank you for purchasing the Performance TourLite Duo tent. Take a few minutes and read the Care and Use suggestions and Set Up instructions before using this tent.



Care and Use:

1. Set up the tent before using it for the first time on a trip. Pick a time when you can set the tent up at home in the day light to become familiar with the assembly.
2. The inside roof and walls of your TourLite Duo may become damp or wet in the morning after a nights use. This does not mean that it is leaking! The dampness is due to condensation. Through perspiration and breathing, all people give off water vapor which can collect on the roof as water after a cool night. Cross ventilation will minimize condensation.
3. When setting up your TourLite Duo tent always choose areas clear of sharp stones or branches. Level places that are not in a low spot are ideal.
4. Never force a jammed zipper. Instead, carefully remove any trapped material. If a zipper separates, gently pull the slider until the zipper is all the way open. Try to close the zipper again- the zipper may have repaired itself. If you use the TourLite Duo in sandy soil conditions clean the zippers by flushing them with fresh water.
5. Never set up the TourLite Duo close to a fire or use any type of flame source in the tent. Although flame retardant materials are used in the construction, this tent, like all tents is flammable.
6. Do not store the TourLite Duo wet. Because of conditions, a tent must sometimes be rolled up when it is wet. Air your tent out at the first opportunity by setting it up in dry conditions.

TourLite Duo Set Up Instructions:

1. Assemble the sections of shock-corded poles.
2. Unroll the tent and spread it out. If it is windy, stake the end of the tent that is facing the wind.

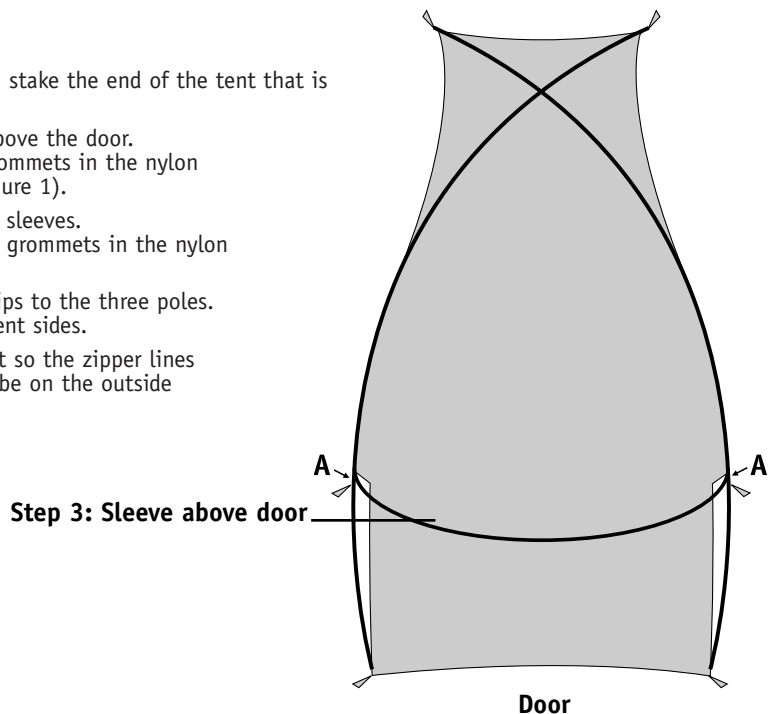


Figure 1. Top view showing tent pole location.

3. Slide one of the poles through the sleeve just above the door. Put the ends of the pole into the appropriate grommets in the nylon webbing at the end of the sleeve. (labeled "A" figure 1).
4. Slide the other two poles through the remaining sleeves. Put the ends of these poles into the appropriate grommets in the nylon webbing at the ends of the sleeves.
5. Stake the tent. Attach the six nylon c shaped clips to the three poles. The clips are sewn onto nylon webbing on the tent sides.
6. Unfurl the rainfly and spread it out over the tent so the zipper lines up with the tent door. The TourLite logo should be on the outside and oriented just to the left of the front zipper.
7. Clip the fly with the nylon buckles to the tent but do not tighten the webbing straps until all of the buckles are clipped.
8. Stake out the vestibule using the two webbing loops on the front of the rainfly.
